born 1942, studied Classic Philology and German studies and published numerous books on Austrian literature from the 20th century, a.o. on Johann Nestroy, Ernst Jandl and Albert Drach. He was the editor of the works of Heimito von Doderer, Thomas Bernhard and many more. He was head of the department of German studies at the University of Vienna and head of the Literary Archives of the Austrian National Library. He received several awards, among them the "Staatspreis für Literaturkritik" 1994 and "Wissenschaftler des Jahres 2007". Wendelin Schmidt-Dengler passed away on September 7, 2008.
